Dear Readers,

As kids start going back to school and the end of "summer" wraps up, it's always a bitter sweet time for me. All of the planning, excitement and energy around summer camp is over, but the start of our fall events, such as the Men's Retreat, Women's Retreat, Fall BBQ, and many other church retreats ramp up. Despite this, summer camp is still at the top of my mind – what good happened, where we can improve for next year, and what kids and parents talking about. What's also at the top of my mind is how we can engage more churches to become involved and send their kids to summer camp. This year we had 280 kids attend 6 weeks of summer camp. Speaking of changed lives, there are many key people that have played an important role in allowing lives to be changed through physically and financially supporting camp over the years. One such person that comes to mind is Ruth Hague, who recently passed away at the age of 89. If you recognize that her last name is associated with camp, it's due to the fact that "The Hague" is named after Ruth and her husband Jack Hague – both of whom played an important role in developing and forming the camp into what it is today. They were visionaries that recognized the need and the importance behind having a Christian camp.

Are you a visionary? Are you looking to change lives? Do you want to play a role in continuously improving summer camp? If so, then I would encourage you to make a contribution to camp between now and the end of the year. To make that contribution have even more impact, I'm going to encourage and challenge you to commit to making one of the following donations to camp:
